Can we do this now so that we have the right to participate in the future? Group believes we should move forward on this so we have this ability in the future? Aprille will do this.
- Hirtle: Do we want to try to find grant funds to support participation in international work? As SAA would likely get observer status, it's reasonable to ask for money to cover costs. Worth looking at into the future.
- Maher: ICA committee. David Sutton, chair, has put out a call for expressions of principles and concepts for a prospective ICA Information paper and a comprehensive position statement. Bill will forward the most recent request to the IPWG for input and check status.
